Now the number of Western missionaries is falling, the danger exists that the native priests will receive less support, and themselves become responsible for the sustenance, study, education and pastoral and social tasks at the service of their underprivileged people.

The contributions they obtain for a holy mass or a prayer novena are often the only source of income.
